

PASTOR OF CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

JOB DESCRIPTION

The Pastor of Children's Ministries primary responsibility is to help children become disciples of Jesus who show and share his kindness, grace and truth.

Overarching Goal: The goal of the Pastor of Children's Ministry is to develop and sustain a vibrant children's ministry across Capstone Church's <u>two church sites</u>. The Pastor of Children's Ministry will work to:

1) Equip and train volunteers to provide meaningful ministry to our children.

2) Provide oversight to the proper implementation of safety procedures for all of Capstone's work among children and youth.

3) Help parents grow in the capacity to help their children be like Jesus.

Unique Job Opportunities and Responsibilities

- Recruit and develop volunteers to lead ministries.
- Effectively communicate with volunteers and parents/guardians.
- Be a present figure at both sites (East and West), to support leaders and families.
- Develop a discipleship strategy for Capstone's children across multiple sites.
- Create opportunities to bless children outside the church and point them to the kindness of Jesus.
 - Previous examples: Soccer camps, community barbecues, Youth Drop-in Center, etc.
- Disciple members of Capstone to show and share the kindness, grace, and truth of Jesus on a weekly basis.

Areas for Future Growth

- Oversee Capstone Youth Ministry.
- Develop a discipleship strategy for Capstone's teenagers, across multiple sites.

 Work with volunteers and staff to build an outreach strategy for families in our area.

All Staff Commitments

- Develop annual ministry plans, goals, and strategies.
- Work with 90-day goals (personal and pastoral).
- Evaluate effectiveness of disciple-making—size is not the only metric for success.
- Participate in all staff meetings, retreats, training and events.
- Attend our Sunday worship gatherings.
- Participate in a house church (weekly in-home disciple making environment for adults).
- Maintain a lifestyle consistent with biblical instruction for Christian living.
- Agree to the C&MA statement of faith
- Work towards the health, beauty, and joy of Capstone Church: its attendees, leaders, volunteers and staff.

Successful candidates will also:

- <u>Capstone's Mission</u> Understand and act in accordance with Capstone's mission, strategy, and yearly goals and participate in Capstone Church's ministry events.
- <u>Competency</u> Have a love for people inside and outside of the church, will know how to organize teams, recruit volunteers, and disciple children and equip parents to do the same.
- <u>Character</u> Demonstrate Christ-like character and agree to walk in an ongoing transformational journey to become more Christ-like through participation in personal devotions, house church, and other church functions
- <u>Accountability</u> Demonstrate appropriate leadership qualities and report to the Site Pastors (East & West).
